# Tweedbank Community Centre 100 Club Policy

### 1. Purpose

The 100 Club is a fundraising initiative to support Tweedbank Community Centre. It also gives participants a chance to win monthly prizes.

#### 2. Membership

- Open to anyone aged 16 or over.
- Members join by paying £5 per month per number.
- Each member is allocated a unique number (or more if paying multiple subscriptions).
- Membership is ongoing until cancelled by the member or the committee.

#### 3. Payments

- Payments are collected **monthly** via approved methods (Wix Paid Plans, Stripe, PayPal, etc.).
- Membership numbers are confirmed **only once payment is received**.
- Members are responsible for ensuring their payment method is valid to remain eligible for the draw.

#### 4. Draws & Prizes

- Draws are held **monthly**, on a date set by the committee.
- 50% of the total monthly pot is allocated for prizes; the remaining 50% goes to the Centre.
- Draws are conducted transparently, ideally in front of the community or via a public video/ social media post.
- Winners will be notified promptly and prizes paid within 7 days.

#### 5. Transparency & Record-Keeping

Records of all members, payments, numbers, and draws will be maintained by the committee.

• Draw results and prize distribution will be **publicly available**.

#### 6. Cancellation & Refunds

- Members may cancel their subscription at any time.
- No refunds are available for the month in which a draw has already taken place.

# 7. Compliance

- The 100 Club will operate in accordance with UK **lottery and gambling regulations** (Small Society Lottery registration if required).
- The committee reserves the right to amend the rules and policy, with members being notified of any changes.

## 8. Dispute Resolution

• Any disputes will be resolved by the **committee**, whose decision will be final.
